DR. A. RANDY McINTOSH

Professor, Department of Biomedical Physiology & Kinesiology, Simon Fraser University. Director, Institute for Neuroscience and Neurotechnology

Dr. McIntosh holds a PhD in psychology and neuroscience with a strong background in statistics. His research journey began at the Rotman Research Institute, University of Toronto, where he developed a keen interest in understanding aging and cognition. Through international collaborations, Dr. McIntosh and his team have created TheVirtualBrain (thevirtualbrain.org), a groundbreaking platform that unites global research efforts.

Dr. McIntosh's vision encompasses two key objectives: 1) integrating their modeling platform into clinical decision-making processes and 2) establishing a user-friendly cloud-based system for brain modeling in research, clinical applications, and education.

Dr. McIntosh recently joined Simon Fraser University, where his research will play a pivotal role in the new Institute for Neuroscience and Neurotechnology.
