

## Limited Term Faculty Position in Hispanic Literature and Cultures Department of Modern Languages and Literatures Faculty of Arts and Humanities Western University, London, Ontario Canada

The Department of Modern Languages and Literatures invites applications for a limited term faculty position (up to four years) at the rank of Assistant Professor in the area of Hispanic Literature and Cultures with a focus on Transatlantic Hispanic Studies and Digital Humanities. Applications will be considered from qualified applicants with a PhD at time of appointment. Solid expertise in teaching with new technologies, and native or near-native fluency in Spanish are required. Expertise in New Literatures of Latin America and Spain is important. Responsibilities will include teaching culture, Digital Humanities, Spanish language and Literature courses, at the undergraduate and graduate levels, graduate examinations, an active role in the Transatlantic Studies programme, and service to the Department and the Faculty. This position will start July 1, 2018 and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
