With global awareness of how germs spread through travel peaked by the COVID-19 pandemic, and after identifying a gap in recent literature, this thematic issue seeks innovative approaches to exploration history at the crossroads with disease.

Submissions might explore the Columbian Exchange, how expeditions helped propagate disease during and after their travels, how disease was treated among Indigenous and non-Indigenous populations, how disease was documented and visualized, among others.

SUBMISSION DETAILS

Proposals should include a 250-word abstract that articulates the aims of the article, why it is innovative, what conclusions it plans to yield, as well as the critical or theoretical framework that will be used, in addition to a 150-word biography sent to [hbarnet2@uwo.ca](mailto:hbarnet2@uwo.ca) and [lbeck@mta.ca](mailto:lbeck@mta.ca).

Articles should be no longer than 8,000 words (included notes) and must closely follow the [journal's style guide](#).
