EXPERIENCE THE NEW DUFF ROBLIN PARKWAY

- Cycle or skate the 46 km trail, located on the west side of the floodway, that begins near the St. Mary's Road Bridge in the south and ends just south of Lockport.
- Enjoy the 2.8 km trail on the east side of the floodway, known as the Kirkness Spur, that runs from near the new pedestrian overpass bridge to Kirkness Road or the 3.2 km paved trail leading from the pedestrian overpass bridge into Birds Hill Provincial Park called the Cedar Bog Spur.
