The Winnipeg Trails Association, City of Winnipeg & partners are holding a '**Community Consultation**' to discuss the potential locations of a multiuse trail between the Fort Garry Bridge and Pembina Hwy. This is a section of the Trans Canada Trail which will travel west along Bishop Grandin Blvd. and offers potential linkages and partnerships with Bishop Grandin Greenway Inc (east of the Red River) with its nearly completed trail and ongoing greenway development. An update on the Fort Garry Bridge Rehab - pedestrian / cycle infrastructure will also be provided.
