## Re: CICLOVIA 2012 Bicycle Related Sponsorship, Volunteer & Participation Opportunities

In its fourth year, the Downtown Winnipeg BIZ, in conjunction with other stakeholders and sponsors, will put on Ciclovia (Sunday, Sept 9 from 11am-6pm). The north side of Broadway will be closed for programming between Main St and Osborne St. Car free streets will also extend from Broadway to Assiniboine Park. **NEW** this year, we will also be putting on a Parade of Lights on Broadway, where the public will have an opportunity to light up their bikes or hold candles and make their way down Broadway, past a series of lit dancers (Saturday, Sept 8). To prepare for the parade, bike lighting will take place Saturday, Sept 8 at 5:30pm at the following locations:

- Omand Park
- St. John's Park
- Lagimodiere Gaboury Park
- Lyndale Dr Park
- Riverview Community Centre
- Memorial Park

We are looking for your help to make these events a success. Please see below areas where we need help by way of sponsorship, volunteering or participating.

## SPONSORSHIP (in-kind or cash):

- Donate bike or fitness gear to provide as prizes to public for Parade of Lights and Ciclovia
- Donate white bike lights for handle bars to provide to participants in Parade of Lights (we have red lights)
- Donate new helmets for child participants in Parade of Lights (to have on hand for those who arrive without a helmet)
- Donate colourful lights to decorate bikes (or cash so we can purchase lights for bikes)



- Donate used helmets to be repurposed as planters and other art during Winnipeg Art Gallery activity at Ciclovia.
- NOTE: We will gladly accept any of the above (and will pick up items from you at your location). Verbal mentions of your shop/group at the event will be made for all those who donate (any value). ## **VOLUNTEERING:**

## Pre-Event (Aug 28 to Sept 6)

- Ride the lit Ciclovia bike to various neighbourhoods to promote the Parade of Light (Aug 28, 29 and 30 from 8:40pm-10pm)
- Put up Ciclovia and Parade of Light posters in your shop/community (posters can be dropped off to you as of Tues, Aug. 28)
- Put up promotional signs on Ciclovia route (meet at Memorial Park, head off with signs by bike or car, shift 6pm-8pm, Thurs, Aug. 30)

## Saturday, September 8

- Assist with lighting bikes at one of the bike decorating stations (shift 5:30pm-7:30pm). Orientation and material pick up at Memorial Park at 4:30pm.
- Provide bike repair services at one of the bike decorating stations & during the ride in to Broadway (shift 6:30pm-8:30pm)
- Lead a group ride from a bike decorating station to Broadway (two leaders per ride, shift 6:30pm-8:30pm). Orientation at Memorial Park at 4:30pm. Safety vests provided.
- Lead a group ride from Memorial Park back to one of the bike decorating neighbourhoods (two leaders per ride, depart at 11:00pm). Safety vests provided.

## Sunday, September 9

- Install directional signs on Ciclovia route (shift 7:30am-11am)
- Act as a marshal for various points of the Ciclovia route (shifts are 11am-2:30pm or 2:30pm-6:00pm). Safety vests and stop signs provided.

- Give a 45 min talk at our Seminar Stage on types of bicycles or gear (slots between 11am-6pm). Other topics are also welcomed!
- Bring out a unique bike to the Bike Show (11am-6pm)
- Set up a booth in the BIKE ZONE to promote bike gear, bike safety or anything cycling related (11am-6pm)
- Provide bicycle repairs services in the BIKE ZONE (11am-6pm)
- Participate in Bike Polo (11am-6pm)

We will also be asking the public to donate old bikes or parts to be repurposed (drop- off in Bike Zone during Ciclovia). If you have a use for old bike parts and are able to pick these up from us after the event, please let us know. The pick-up will be from Memorial Park on Monday, Sept 10 between noon-2pm.
