REGARDING: 2017 - 2018 PRELIMINARY UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA GRADUATE FELLOWSHIP ALLOCATION

Please find below the preliminary allocation for the University of Manitoba Graduate Fellowships for the 2017 - 2018 academic year. Allocations are based on the average enrollment over the previous three years (2013/14 - 2015/16).

#### Please note that:

- 1. Units must use Master's and doctoral awards in accordance with their allocation.
- 2. A negative allocation indicates that the unit has more UMGF awards currently active for its students than recent enrollment would support.
- 3. Unit allocations have been rounded to the nearest whole number (any allocation less than 0.5 has been rounded down).
- 4. In some cases, coordination at the Budget Faculty level of the allocations may be desired. Individual units participating in such coordination must agree to it and any resulting arrangement must be approved by the Faculty of Graduate Studies.
- 5. Please note that additional allocations may be made in the winter term as unit enrollments for 2016/17 are available from the Office of Institutional Analysis, as well as later in the spring after the Tri-Council agencies announce their results (at that time students who receive a tricouncil grant must accept it and decline any UMGF previously awarded).

### **Using Your Allocation**

Recommendations may be made immediately using the online recommendation form available on our website <a href="https://universityofmanitoba.formstack.com/forms/umgf\_rec\_form">https://universityofmanitoba.formstack.com/forms/umgf\_rec\_form</a> (paper recommendations are not accepted). Please keep in mind that a PhD level award has a commitment of up to 4 years and a Master's level award has a commitment of up to 2 years. The Faculty of Graduate Studies will send out award notices to all recommended recipients after confirming eligibility.

Please note that all recommendations must be made prior to October 1, 2017. Please let us know as soon as possible if you are unable to use your allocation for the 2017-2018 academic year so that funds may be redistributed.
