Recommendations should be made prior to June 30, 2011 to be eligible for any supplementary awards or upgrades. We ask that you make the majority of your recommendations prior to the end of September. Please let us know as soon as possible if you are unable to use your allocation for the 2011/2012 academic year so that we or your Budget Faculty can redistribute the funds.
