Student Leaders Volunteer Mission to Cuba: May 25- June 3, 2008

This unique educational experience awards ten university students (Jewish and non-Jewish) the opportunity to spend one week learning about Cuba, notably the Cuban Jewish community that numbers 1,500 people. Throughout the trip, students will learn about Cuban history and society through meetings with community leaders, professionals, journalist, academics, and NGO's. Modern Cuban society is in a stage of rapid transition brought on by a shift in national leadership. This mission will explore the challenges faced by various communities (e.g., poverty, and communism) as well as the current change in government and its impact on Cuban citizens.

Moreover, in keeping with Jewish principles of charity, justice and "tikkun olam" (repairing the world), the group will undertake various social action projects, including hospital visits, cemetery maintenance, organization/stocking of food, teaching English/Hebrew to the Jewish Day School, and medical donations. The mission will be centralized in Havana, but will branch out and visit various communities within Cuba (i.e., Santa Clara, Cienfuegos, Camaguey, and Trinidad.) We will also have the opportunity to connect with Cuban University students and spend a meaningful Shabbat with the Jewish community in Havana.

The trip is heavily subsidized and will only cost \$1,000 per person (this includes flights, hotels, and food). Additional subsidies are available.
