

Keynote Talk by Crystal Gail Fraser

<u>Crystal Gail Fraser</u> (she/her) is Gwichyà Gwich'in, from Inuvik and Dachan Choo Gèhnjik in the Northwest Territories. Her research focuses on the history of experiences at student Indian Residential Schools in the Inuvik Region (1959 to 1996). Crystal serves on national and international committees; she is a member of the Governing Circle of the National Centre for Truth and Reconciliation, a director at Gwich'in Council International, and a member of the National Advisory Committee on Residential School Missing Children and Unmarked Graves. In Fall 2022, Crystal awarded the prestigious was Distinguished Academic Early Career Award from the Confederation of Alberta Faculty Associations. She is an Assistant Professor in History and Native Studies at the University of Alberta.
