Please note RE: Internal Deadlines:

Researchers are advised to contact their <u>Research Facilitators</u> as early in the proposal development process as possible in order to ensure time for effective feedback. At this stage, incomplete proposals or portions of proposals still in development can be reviewed.

The internal deadline, not the agency deadline, should be considered the effective deadline for submission of a complete proposal to the Office of Research Services with all components (including applicant signatures and a completed FAAF) in place. <u>Proposals not submitted to ORS</u> by the internal deadline may not receive a complete review prior to submission.
