Graduate Course Announcement for Fall Term (2012)

HUMAN NEUROANATOMY (ANAT 7392)

This is a <u>3 credit hour</u> course (Aug. – Dec) held on the Bannatyne Campus. It will be of particular interest to graduate students whose research is in Neuroscience. This course will provide an introduction to the **structure & function of the human central nervous system from an anatomical perspective**.

The course has 2 components:

- 1. **Lectures** that will present a systematic survey of human neuroanatomy, and
- 2. **Laboratory sessions** in which students will examine and study the 3-dimensional structure of the human nervous system.
