DR. VINCENT LELIEVRE

Full Professor, Neuroscience, The University of Strasbourg, France

Dr. Lelievre received his PhD in Molecular and Cellular Biology at the University of Poitiers in Poitiers, France. He completed postdoctoral work at the University of California as a Jonsson Cancer Centre Foundation Fellow, served as a Research Assistant at UCLA, and as an InsermAvenir Fellow at the Robert Debre Pediatric Hospital in Paris, France. Dr. Lelievre is the Head of the Joint Masters Program in Neuroscience between institutes in Strasbourg, Basel, and Freiburg and has served in this position from 2011 to the present. Dr. Lelievre's research interests focus on neuropeptides in the placenta and the role of placental neuropeptides and prenatal stress in the development of microcephaly, neurodevelopmental and psychiatric disorders.
