HUMAN NEUROANATOMY (ANAT 7392)

This is a <u>3 credit hour</u> course held on the Bannatyne Campus (Jan. 2015 – Apr. 2015). It will be of particular interest to graduate students whose research is in neuroscience. This course will provide an overview of the structure & function of the human central nervous system from an anatomical perspective.

The course has 2 components:

- 1. **Lectures**, **student presentations**, and **interactive sessions** that will provide a systematic survey of human neuroanatomy, and
- 2. **Laboratory sessions** in which students will examine and study the 3-dimensional structure of the human nervous system.
