## HUMAN NEUROANATOMY (ANAT 7392)

This is a **3 credit hour** course held on the Bannatyne Campus (**Jan. 2016 – Apr. 2016**). It will be of particular interest to graduate students whose research is in neuroscience. This course will provide an overview of the **structure & function of the human central nervous system from an anatomical perspective.**

The course has 2 components:
