DR. WATARU INOUE

Associate Professor, Department of Physiology and Pharmacology, Western University.

Dr. Inoue obtained his bachelor's and master's degree at Kyoto University in Japan, followed by his Ph.D at McGill University. Following his doctoral work, Dr. Inoue held a post-doctoral fellowship at the University of Calgary before joining Western University in London, Ontario. Currently Dr. Inoue is an Associate Professor at Western University and a leading scholar in studying the mechanisms of stress-induced neural plasticity. The goal of Wataru Inoue's research is to understand the effects of stress on the functioning of the brain, and consequently behaviour.
