DR. DALIA L. ROTSTEIN, MD, MPH

Assistant Professor, University of Toronto, Department of Medicine

Dr. Dalia Rotstein is an assistant professor of medicine at the University of Toronto and neurologist specialized in multiple sclerosis (MS) and other demyelinating diseases. Her research is focused on the epidemiology of multiple sclerosis, neuromyelitis optica spectrum disorder (NMOSD), and MOG antibody associated disease (MOGAD). She has a particular interest in the roles of the prodrome, sex, ethnicity, and migration in these conditions. She is the Principal Investigator for CANOPTICS, the first Canadian national prospective study to investigate adults with NMOSD, MOGAD, and other atypical demyelinting conditions.
