2. As of September 2014 onward, applications for funding support for FACULTY TRAVEL to CONFERENCES will no longer be eligible under this Program. FACULTY members are encouraged to seek funding support for such travel from their respective Deans/Department Heads. Travel to attend conferences directly related to research may be funded from the research grants of Researchers. We are writing to initiate the call for applications for the semi-annual Conference Sponsorship Program and Student Travel Support to Competitions. (The next call for applications will be for March 31st, 2015.)

Our offices have jointly allocated a total budget of \$30K/year (\$15K/competition) for this program with priority consideration given as follows: where the University's exposure (in descending order) is international down to departmental; academic value; and financial support provided by the Department and/or Dean/Director offices.

The Conference Sponsorship Program is designed to primarily support the:

A) Attraction of Conferences to the University of Manitoba. Applications for funding to host these Conferences are accepted from FACULTY and STUDENTS.

The Student Travel Support to Competitions portion may also be awarded under this fund as follows:

- B) Student Group Travel to Competitions outside of Manitoba. Student Groups must:
  - i. be traveling to "Competitions" at a National or International level
  - ii. be representing the University of Manitoba in the competition

NOTE: Student travel costs to solely attend Conferences are NOT funded under this Program

Applications <u>will not</u> be accepted for Conferences/Competitions which will take place <u>prior</u> to the competition deadline date.

## Application packages MUST be accompanied by:

- 1) Application Form Completed in full and signed by:
  - i. Applicant
  - ii. Department Head
  - iii. Dean/Director
  - iv. (and if applicable, Supervisor required for all STUDENT requests)
- 2) A Budget outlining income amounts, funding sources and anticipated expenses.
- 3) Written Support describing the merits of the proposal must be provided from the:
  - i. the Applicant's Department
  - ii. (and if applicable, Supervisor required for all STUDENT requests)
- 4) Matching Financial Support provided by the Department and/or Faculty (and if applicable, the Supervisor) is expected to be equal to the Applicant's request for funding through this program.

Funding for successful applicants will be transferred to the respective Office of the Dean/Director; that office will arrange for the disbursement of funds.
