 - ii. How your research may contribute to your community; and
 - iii. Proposed workplan to develop your research idea, including a timeline and how your courses and other activities will contribute to the development of your ideas.
 - ii) If you have identified a thesis project, include:
 - i. Purpose and objectives of the thesis project;
 - ii. How your research may contribute to your community;
 - iii. Description of proposed participants, methodology and dissemination plan; and
 - iv. Workplan, including a timeline for completing the thesis research.
 - b) Copy of acceptance into graduate program.
 - c) Transcripts for all degrees (photocopies/scans of official transcripts or web transcripts are accepted).
 - d) Applicant's CV/resume (degrees and employment categories are mandatory in your CV/Resume, and we recommend adding community involvement (if any)).
