




Salma Serry is food history researcher, artist, and filmmaker, pursuing a phd in History at University of Toronto. She is also the founder of @Sufra_Archive, a digital library and social media platform dedicated to West Asian and North African food history and culture. She was recently awarded the Arab Fund for Arts and Culture (AFAC) and Arab Council for Social Sciences grant for her ongoing project that documents culinary ephemera from the region. She was recently commissioned research art projects by Art Jameel-Dubai, Hayy Jameel-Jeddah, the Arab Council for Social Sciences-Beirut, the Islamic Biennial in Jeddah, and Cairo Design Week, on themes surrounding the intersection of food history, culture and arts.
