

External Grant Support, 2019-20

THE UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA INSTITUTE FOR THE HUMANITIES

seeks proposals for its **External Grant Support** program. This funding source was established in order to help researchers in the Faculty of Arts who are seeking external funding for conferences, workshops, colloquia, and other local research events. It is designed to provide opportunities for scholars to secure support, both cash and in kind, from the UMIH in order to leverage funds from other agencies. This program has been devised with SSHRC Connections and SSHRC Partnership Engage grants in mind, but it is open to applicants targeting other funding agencies or organizations. Applicants are asked to contact the UMIH with the details of the grant before applying to ensure that their application can be supported under the UMIH mandate.

ELIGIBILITY

The PI must be a member of the University of Manitoba Faculty of Arts. Applications involving inter-faculty, inter-university, or university-community collaborations are welcome.

NATURE AND EXTENT OF SUPPORT

The UMIH will provide \$1,500 combined with up to \$2,500 in administrative and in-kind contributions, for a total of up to \$4,000 in support of a grant proposal. Successful applicants must apply for external funding in order to begin making use of the cash support. The needs of every proposal are unique and the Institute will work closely with faculty to ensure that they have adequate administrative and logistical support. A maximum of two projects will be supported.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Applications should include:

- A copy of your proposal for a SSHRC Connections, SSHRC Partnership Engage, or other relevant grant.
- A one-page summary of what you intend to do with the \$1,500 and administrative and in-kind support you will receive.

DEADLINE

Proposals submitted before **January 7th, 2020** will be prioritized. After this date, the deadline is rolling.
