This lecture explores the ways notions of authorship change in social media. By watching YouTube videos about public cancellations for moral missteps, TikTok memes about cats, and Twitch streams of people just hanging out in chairs, this lecture will examine the ways that authors' interactions with their audiences arise in the composition of internet media.

She is the co-founder of Victorian Samplings, a podcast of the crafting communities project, and she is an Arts & Culture reporter at The Manitoban.
