This course examines the anatomy, evolution, behaviour, functional morphology, paleogeography, and paleoecology of dinosaurs. Evidence for the lifestyle of dinosaurs will be analyzed using dinosaur fossils and their surrounding rocks. The role of new dinosaur discoveries and their role in changing scientific ideas and public perceptions will be explored.
