Physical Education Instructor **10-11 Weeks Starting June 21** **\$10.00/hour**

Phys. Ed. Instructors teach various sports, phys. ed. activities and games to children ages 4 – 16 throughout their week at camp. Instructors (2 per group) will have a group of 12-17 children at any given time and are expected to teach, lead and participate during each scheduled activity.

Group Leader **10-11 Weeks Starting June 21** **\$10.00/hour**

Group leaders are responsible for leading groups of up to 17 children to their daily activities. They are expected to assist in teaching both classroom and physical education lessons/activities, manage group behaviour, handle participant medication, participate in all activities and create a fun and safe environment for participants. Children are aged 5 - 16 and activities vary from special interest to sport programs.

Support Worker **10-11 Weeks Starting June 21** **\$11.39/hour**

Support Workers provide 1-on-1 attention and support to children who require assistance throughout their time at camp. They are expected to assist children become integrated into their group, participate in all camp activities and create a fun and safe experience at Mini U.
