

MOT Year 1 Registration Instructions for 2025-2026

Master of Occupational Therapy (MOT) students are required to register themselves through Aurora Student. **It is important to check Aurora Student for your registration time.** The MOT program is a closed program so there is a spot in every class for each admitted student.

To begin your registration, go to Aurora Student at Aurora.umanitoba.ca. You will be prompted to log in using your UM Microsoft Login. Select view all cards, then Aurora Registration.

1. Register for the courses listed in the chart below. Do **NOT** use the 'Look Up Classes' option. You will only be required to enter the course reference numbers (CRN). Register for both Fall 2025 and Winter 2026 courses before classes start.
2. Register for each course **SEPARATELY in the following order**: First Spanned courses, next Fall 2025 courses, and then Winter 2026 courses. Students will be advised (via e-mail in 2026) when the Aurora Student system is available to accept Summer 2026 registrations.
3. Select a **registration term** before moving onto the Add or Drop Classes screen.
4. When you register for a spanned course (runs over both Fall and Winter Terms), the system will automatically add the second half of the course (Part B) in Winter Term.
5. To process your registration requests, you must click on the '**Submit Changes**' button.
6. Pay all fees by the fee payment deadlines published in U of M Academic Calendar.
