

MOT Year 2 Registration Instructions for 2026-2027

Master of Occupational Therapy (MOT) students are required to register themselves through Aurora Student. Registration for Fall 2026 opens today, June 15, 2026, for Bannatyne Campus students. **It is important to check Aurora Student for your registration time.** The MOT program is a closed program so there is a spot in every class for each admitted student.

To begin your registration, go to Aurora Student at [aurora.umanitoba.ca](https://www.umanitoba.ca/aurora) and follow the instructions provided in the guide: <https://www.umanitoba.ca/registrar/aurora>

You will be prompted to log in using your UM Microsoft Login. Select view all cards, then Aurora Registration. Select Enrolment and Academic Records, then Registration and Exams.

1. Register for the courses listed in the chart below. Do **NOT** use the 'Find Classes' option. You will only be required to enter the course reference numbers (CRN). Register for both Fall 2026 and Winter 2027 courses before classes start in 2026.
2. Register for each course **SEPARATELY** in the following order: First Spanned courses, next Fall 2026 courses, and then Winter 2027 courses.
3. Select a **registration term** before moving onto the Add or Drop Classes screen.
4. When you register for a spanned course (runs over both Fall and Winter Terms), the system will automatically add the second half of the course (Part B) in Winter Term.
5. To process your registration requests, you must click on the '**Submit Changes**' button.
6. Pay all fees by the fee payment deadlines published in U of M Academic Calendar

Registration Exceptions

Students who have a failing grade(s) registered against them and/or have other outstanding academic matters (i.e. deferred or supplemental examinations, modified program, etc.) in regard to the previous academic session will not be allowed to register using Aurora Student until instructed to do so. An email giving specific registration info will be sent to students falling into this category.

Students on “Hold”

A Hold is a block placed on a Student's Account by the University Administration. Depending on the reason for the Hold, limited or no services will be provided to the student until the Hold is removed. To view any Holds on your records, log in to Aurora Student, select Student Records, then View Holds.

In addition, there may be advisor or program Holds that restrict registration. In the MOT program, these typically relate to the Student Progress Reports. A Hold is applied to each student until reports are received and reviewed by the Faculty of Graduate Studies. If you encounter this Hold, we ask that you wait a few days and try again. If you are unable to register after 2-3 attempts over several days, then contact Olu Bobmanuel.

Applying to Graduate

The OT Department will notify the Faculty of Graduate Studies about your eligibility to graduate. All graduation and convocation communication from the Registrar's Office (Convocation) will be emailed to your U of M email account. Check for Convocation information regularly on the Convocation website.

E-mail Accounts
