SLIC offers ***goal-oriented, task-based, intensive rehabilitation*** for
Manitobans with heart or lung conditions such as:

- Coronary Artery Disease
- Heart Failure
- Heart Attack Recovery
- Heart Valve problems
- Cardiomyopathy
- Cardiac Surgery
- TAVI
- COPD
- Emphysema
- Bronchiectasis
- Cystic Fibrosis
- Fibrotic lung disease
- Or other heart or lung related conditions

SLIC is open from **October - December**. Rehabilitation programs at SLIC are **free of charge** and may occur **in person**.

Your condition must be stable with the ability to **participate in low to moderate intensity activity**.

Care is provided by students from the University of Manitoba Rady Faculty of Health Sciences under the supervision of licensed healthcare practitioners. Students from Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Respiratory Therapy and others may be involved in your care.
