



Hello OT and PT Students,

Orthotics Prosthetics Canada (OPC) is hosting the O&P National Certification Exams on Friday, May 29th, 2026 and Saturday May 30th, 2026 at the SSCY Center (1155 Notre Dame Ave in Winnipeg Manitoba). At this time the Orthotics section is looking to **recruit 10 healthy volunteers** to be patient models for the exam. It is a great opportunity to meet professionals in the field and get an inside look at an OSCE-style exam. To compensate you for your time OPC will pay \$20/hour plus travel costs if necessary.

We are still working out the timeline and logistics, so for now we would like volunteers to be available the afternoon and evening of Friday, May 29th, and all day on Saturday May 30th. There is a very small chance that some candidates will need to be examined on the morning of May 31st as well.

Patient Model Expectations: You will be required to simulate the role of a patient in a scenario requiring Orthotic intervention. Each patient model will be partnered with 2 certified examiners, and you will repeatedly complete the same station for each candidate. You will be assigned your role at a training session on Friday, and the exam will take place on Saturday and possibly Sunday. Some stations may be video-recorded and distributed to designated exam officials for review.

If you are interested in helping with this year's exam, please email me at **cert.examo@gmail.com**. Some stations require off-the-shelf devices fit to your body, so please include the following in your response so I can better assign roles before the exam weekend:

1. Height
2. Weight
3. Waist circumference
4. Hip circumference
5. Preferred gender pronouns
6. If you have volunteered for the exams in the past
