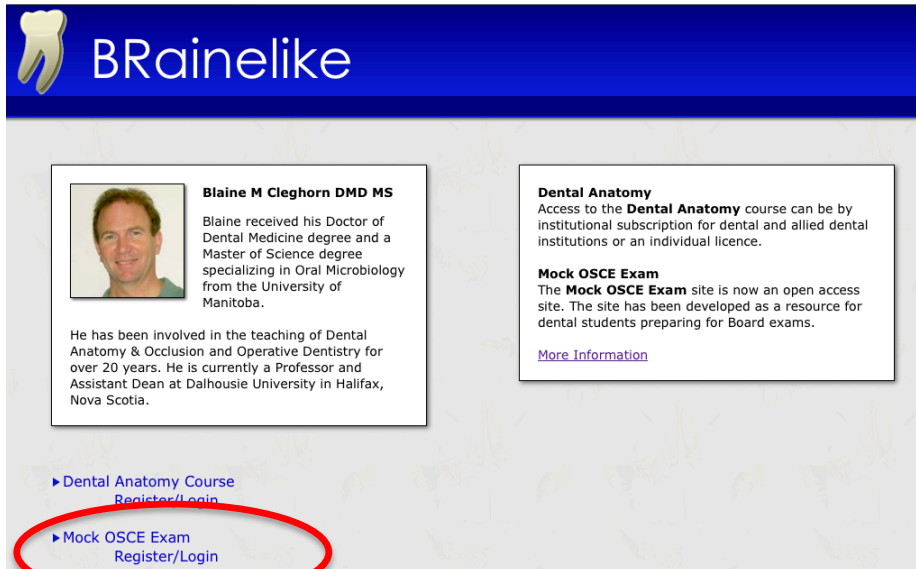


Mock OSCE Exam
