For Associate/Full Professor rank, applicants should have an established record of outstanding research accomplishment and teaching; they will be expected to teach and guide the research of Master's and doctoral students, to be committed to a continuing cutting-edge research program that has direct implications for policy reform, and to help build the new School of Public Policy. Applicants must have a Ph.D. in a related discipline, such as public policy, anthropology, demography, economics, sociology or political science by the time of appointment. Salary will be competitive and commensurate with education and experience. The appointment will commence on July 1, 2014.

Applications should include a letter of interest, a CV, and a sample of research work. For the Assistant Professor rank three letters of recommendation, and, for the Associate/Full Professor rank names and contact information of 3-5 references, need to be submitted.
