## 2023 Scholarship Information

The Sport Medicine \& Science Council of Manitoba (SMSCM) has established a scholarship to offer financial support to students of its member groups. The main purpose of the SMSCM is to facilitate and coordinate member associations in common endeavors in sport medicine and sport sciences such as conferences, symposia, research, and public education. Other objectives are to initiate and promote education and research programs related to the field of sport medicine and sport sciences and to establish guidelines designed to ensure high standards of care for sport participants.

The Sport Medicine \& Science Council of Manitoba provides an annual award of \$1000.00 to promote the achievements and to help further the education of students in, or entering the related fields. There is a maximum of two award winners. The award is to be presented each year at the SMSCM Annual General Meeting by the President of the Sport Medicine and Science Council of Manitoba.

The Sport Medicine \& Science Council of Manitoba Executive Committee will select the student whom:

- has achieved a cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 3.5 or equivalent;
- continues their program in the next ensuing regular academic session;
- shows outstanding volunteer work related to sport medicine;
- displays an impressive extracurricular background related to sport medicine;
- displays competence and dedication to their field, including professionalism, enthusiasm and commitment.

Students cannot win this scholarship in two consecutive years. Students should fill out this scholarship application and submit with a copy of their transcripts. The application is to be sent to the Sport Medicine \& Science Council of Manitoba office and the Selection Committee will select a winner.

All submitted applications will be evaluated based on an established scale, which assesses the written components.

## Eligibility Criteria

- A current post secondary student, or a high school attending post secondary institute in a related field in the upcoming academic year, with a grade point average minimum of 3.5 or equivalent. Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible.
- Demonstrated volunteer work related to a sport medicine field.
- Extracurricular/Leadership experiences related to sport medicine or athletic pursuits.
- Displays confidence, dedication, professionalism, enthusiasm in all leadership roles

2. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation
3. Transcripts (unofficial/administration versions are acceptable)
