As a reminder, below are the ORS deadlines for submitting research proposals and FAFs (Funding Application Approval Form):

For large, complex grant applications (e.g., tri-agency major programs, those that require matching funds and/or additional institutional support, etc.)

- 2 weeks in advance of agency deadline

For other regular and/or 'rolling' and one-time grants:

- 7 days in advance of agency deadline

Also as a reminder, researchers should work with the University's Research Facilitators early in the proposal development stage.
