Dr. V. Wee Yong

Dr. Yong is a Professor at the University of Calgary and holds the Canada Research Chair in Neuroimmunology. He will introduce his laboratory results that illustrate the connection between exercise and repair of a lesion on the spinal cord. He will also provide updates on medications that are used in MS.
