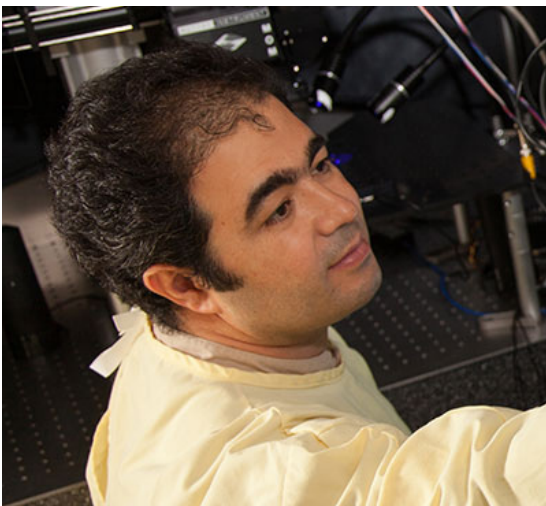

University of Lethbridge

Majid Mohajerani, Ph.D., is an associate professor and Bryan Kolb Professorship Chair at the Canadian Centre for Behavioural Neuroscience, University of Lethbridge with a research focus on neural dynamics with particular emphasis on sensorimotor integration and memory systems. Prior to moving to the University of Lethbridge as an Alberta Innovation Chair in Healthy Brain Aging and Dementia, he was a post-doctoral researcher at the University of British Columbia. He combines optical imaging, electrophysiology, behavioural methods, and computational tools to study how different brain areas communicate with one another and how (a) memory is encoded and consolidated, (b) motor movement is generated based on sensory inputs.
