I am pleased to announce that the first official meeting of the **40th Plant Science Graduate Student Symposium (PSGSS) Organizing Committee** occurred on July 25th.

The PSGSS is an annual two-day symposium that aims to bring graduate students together from border universities and expose them to new and ongoing plant science research initiatives. The agriculture and agri-food sector is vital to the Canadian economy – generating \$150.0 billion of the nation's GDP and employing 2.3 million people.¹ Indeed, the sector is paramount to the world at large, though it faces ample challenges. This symposium intends to highlight research and advancements in the sector via the following disciplines:

- Agronomy
- Plant Breeding
- Weed Science

- Plant Genomics
- Plant Pathology
- Weed Ecology
- Molecular Biology
 Plant Physiology

I am certain that the graduate students in our department will play a large role in this symposium, as made evident through many research presentations at the recent Carman Field Day. The Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences received \$102 million in external research funding from 2016 to 2021,² \$16.9 million alone in the most recent fiscal year,³ which is indicative of the importance of the research conducted by the faculty's departments.

Additionally, the symposium provides an ideal environment for professional development of scientific knowledge and communication skills, through presentations and networking.

As in years past, the symposium is made possible through collaboration between the University of Manitoba, University of Saskatchewan and North Dakota State University. The symposium venue has rotated between these academic institutions from year to year.
