

Manitoba Association of Plant Biologists Graduate Fellowship

The Manitoba Association of Plant Biologists has established an endowment fund at the University of Manitoba to support graduate students in plant biology.

Fellowships shall be offered to students who:

- (1) are enrolled full-time in the Faculty of Graduate Studies at the University of Manitoba, in an M.Sc. or Ph.D. program, with a thesis topic in any aspect of plant biology;
- (2) have achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5 over the last two regular academic sessions;
- (3) show great potential for research, as judged by the selection committee.

Applicants for the fellowships will be required to submit an application on or before the designated deadline date. The application will include a curriculum vitae, a summary of proposed research including objectives, significance and methods, one letter of reference in support of the application (the letter is to be from an academic in the area of plant biology and submitted confidentially to the Department of Biological Sciences, Room 212 Bio Sci Bldg. or by e-mail to biograd@umanitoba.ca) and a current academic transcript (web transcript is acceptable).

Recipients may apply for this award in subsequent years (there is no restriction on how many times one can hold this award).
