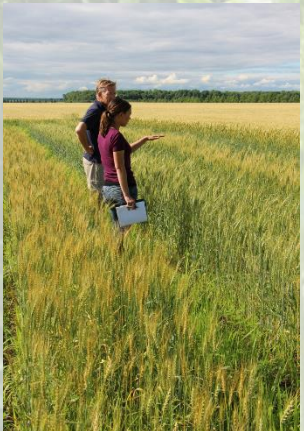


2017 Participatory Plant Breeding Field Day
