She teaches curriculum-embedded GPD, Introduction to Graduate Studies, Design Thinking for Scientists, Teaching In Higher Education, all with a students-as-partners model, spearheads the GLSE PhD Leaders Program, and advises numerous student initiatives. She has presented to over 3000 learners at numerous keynotes and conference sessions throughout the USA, Canada and Asia.
