- **Combined First Aid + BLS courses**

We can work directly with faculties and student groups to coordinate training based on **program requirements, student numbers, certification timelines, and academic schedules.**

Training can be coordinated at both University locations, including the **Bannatyne and Fort Garry campuses**, providing students a convenient option close to where they study.
