



Aboriginal Issues Press Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria: The scholarship will be awarded to applicants who:

- Are enrolled part-time or full-time in the Faculty of Graduate Studies (Master's or Ph.D. program).
- Have registered in or completed a graduate-level course on Indigenous issues.
- Have a research focus on Indigenous issues.
- Achieved a degree grade point average of at least 3.5.
- Demonstrated a commitment to sharing the results of their research.

Application Details: Please submit the following by the deadline:

- A current transcript (University of Manitoba students may submit a Student History that is available upon request from the Registrar's Office).
Note: Web transcripts will not be accepted.
- Proof of registration in or completion of a graduate-level course covering Indigenous issues.
- Have a research focus on Indigenous issues.
- Have demonstrated efforts to share the results of your research.
- A one-page statement explaining how their research relates to Indigenous issues and how this research will be or has been disseminated in order to be considered for this award.

Award Value: Approximately \$500 - \$1,500
