

# NSERC USRA 2026

## Research Opportunities Await Next Summer!

Enhance your studies with hands-on research experience and receive financial support through these awards. A great way to build skills and explore your interests

To qualify for this award, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must be a Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident of Canada.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- Must be registered as a full-time student in any Bachelor's degree program offered by the University of Manitoba.
- Students in their first year of study are not eligible.
- Students pursuing a second Bachelor's degree are eligible, provided they do not hold a higher degree in the natural sciences.
- Students may hold a maximum of three (3) NSERC awards during their university career.
- Supervisors for NSERC awards must hold NSERC funding.
- Co-op students may hold the NSERC award simultaneously with a co-op placement.
- To be considered for the Indigenous scholars funding, meritorious applicants must self-identify as Indigenous in their application.
- To be considered for the Black scholars funding, meritorious applicants must self-identify as Black in their application.

### Award Value:

The minimum award amount for a NSERC USRA research position is \$7,500.
