

Riddell Faculty PhD THESIS Prize

The Clayton H. Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources offers an annual prize of \$1,000 to the student who has successfully completed all the requirements for a Doctoral degree program delivered by any unit in the Riddell Faculty with high academic standing and who has completed the best Doctoral thesis.

The annual prize is offered to the graduate student who:

- has successfully completed all of the requirements for a Doctoral degree program delivered by any unit in the Clayton H. Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources;
- has achieved a minimum degree grade point average of 3.5 (or equivalent) based on the last 60 credit hours of study;
- has received approval of their thesis, and has submitted the final version to the Faculty of Graduate Studies between September 1 and August 31 of the 2024-2025 academic year;
- from among those candidates who also meet criteria (1) through (3), has completed the best Doctoral thesis, as determined by the selection committee.

Nominations will be invited from faculty of the University of Manitoba. Nominations must be accompanied by the external examiner's report, two letters of support, one from the candidate's thesis advisor and one from a member of the candidate's examining committee. The letters should describe and explain the strengths, merits, and innovative nature of the thesis and the candidate's research.
