

Philip and Marjorie Eckman Scholarships in Honour of Dr. Justin DeLury

A scholarship established by Marjorie Eckman in honour of her husband, Philip Eckman, a geology graduate of the University of Manitoba, and Dr. J.S. DeLury, supporting students in the Department of Earth Sciences who demonstrate academic excellence and a strong interest in mining or hard rock geology.

To be eligible, applicant must be:

1. An Undergraduate student who:

- Is a Canadian citizen
- Has completed at least two years of full-time study at the University of Manitoba
- Is enrolled full-time in the upcoming academic year in the Department of Earth Sciences
- Is pursuing Honours or the Major program
- Has a minimum GPA of 3.5

2. A Graduate student who:

- Is Canadian citizen
- Is enrolled full-time in a Master's or Ph.D. program in the Department of Earth Sciences
- Is conducting thesis research in mining engineering, mining geology, geophysics, or hard rock geology
- Has a minimum GPA of 3.5 based on the last 60 credit hours (or equivalent)

Application must include:

1. A résumé outlining employment and relevant experience

2. A short essay (300 words or less) that includes:

- For Undergraduate Students:
 - A description of your academic focus, including courses or thesis/report projects related to mining engineering or hard rock geology
 - A summary of work experience that reflects familiarity with the mining profession and its demands
- For Graduate Students:
 - A brief description of your research interests and how your thesis relates to mining engineering or hard rock geology
 - A summary of work experience demonstrating understanding and readiness for a career in the mining industry

Award value: Maximum of \$2,750
