

"Health," here, is widely defined and highly inclusive, and can be interpreted through the lenses of many different disciplines including but not limited to: Queer Studies; Gender Studies; Anti-Racist Studies; Indigenous Studies; Critical Science Studies; Disability Studies; Sociology; Anthropology; Public Health; Epidemiology; Biomedicine; Community Health Sciences; History; Philosophy; Psychology; Literature and Literary Studies; Linguistics; and so on! Submissions can be grounded in any type of research methodology.

ALL ACCEPTED TYPES OF WORK – the presentations/papers, posters, and art piece – will be evaluated, and the best work in each category will each receive a prize. Runners up will also receive a prize of lesser value!!

WE WELCOME SUBMISSIONS IN THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

SCHOLARLY PAPERS AND PRESENTATIONS

Presentations should be a total of 20 minutes. They can be in the form of PowerPoint presentations, or can be the form of reading a paper.

SCIENTIFIC POSTERS

We welcome posters on original work, on the topic of queer health and healthcare.

Successful posters will be described in 10 minute presentations at the Student Workshop, as well as displayed in the Joe Doupe Concourse.

TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A PAPER/PRESENTATION, OR POSTER: Please submit a 250 word abstract using <u>the Google Form</u>. Abstracts will be peer reviewed.

ART PIECES

We welcome art pieces of any medium on the topic of queer health and healthcare.

Successful applicants will have the opportunity to discuss their work with workshop attendees for 10 minutes. Successful applicants will also have their work displayed in the Joe Doupe Concourse.

TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR AN ART PIECE: Please submit a 250 word artist's statement and/or an image of the art piece (if completed) using the Google Form. All statements and/or images will be reviewed by a professor in the Department of Fine Arts.
