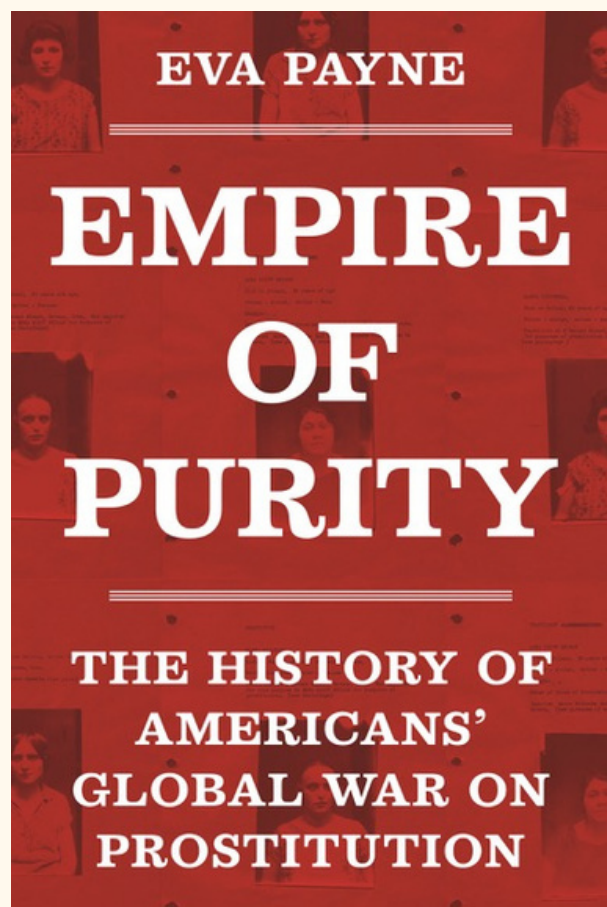

Between the 1870s and 1930s, Americans transformed sexual vice into an international political and humanitarian concern.
